<u>Artillery Club's Foreign Field Trip – Athens – 06 to 11 October 2019</u> Coordinator: Commandant Michael Flood (Retd)

Introduction

The Artillery Club's 2019 Foreign Field Trip will take place in Athens, with Sunday, 06 October and Friday, 11 October the travel days. By kind permission of the Hellenic National Defence General Staff, the trip includes a visit to the Artillery School, located in Néa Péramos, Attikis, on Monday, 07 October.

As with the successful trips in 2015 to Madrid and Segovia, in 2016 to Granada and Malaga, in 2017 to Lisbon, and in 2018 to Vienna, Commandant Michael Flood (Retd) is the Field Trip Coordinator.

Our Liaison Officer will be Colonel Nikolaos J. Pentsas, Artillery Directorate, Hellenic Army General Staff.

Programme

The Programme is attached as Annex A.

Participants are free to organise their own activities in Athens, such as visiting the Acropolis, the Parthenon, the Temple of Hephaestus, the Arc of Hadrian, the Acropolis Museum, Syntagma Square (for the Changing of the Guards), Ermou Street for a shopping spree, the National Library, Plaka and Monastiraki Flea Market, art galleries and museums.

Should Participants wish to enjoy the rejuvenating waters of the Greek seas, the closest beach is just 9 kilometers away from the recommended hotel.



Verbal Brief

Commandant Michael Flood (Retd) will provide a verbal brief at 1930hrs, on Sunday, 06 October in the lobby of the Polis Grand Hotel.

Participants

Preparations

Participants are advised to check their passports, to have appropriate travel insurance, and to have in their possession a current European Health Insurance card.

Participants are also encouraged to bring appropriate dress, including Club Tie, for the visit to the Hellenic Artillery School. The Dress Code for this event will be jacket and tie.

- **Dinner 10 Oct**: €30 per person, three course dinner, less beverages.
