
Organisation of the Artillery Corps 1923 - Present 1923 (DFR No. 3), Total = 1 Battery






NB: Between 1948 and 1959, a number of independent FCA Batteries were in existence. These included the 41st stand 42nd Btys in Dublin, the 44th and 45th Btys in Cork and the 46th Bty in Mullingar.

The Defence Forces embarked on reorganisation in November 2012 which led to the creation of two Brigade Artillery Regiments. These were no longer Field Artillery Regiments as they also had Air Defence elements. With the introduction
